Total Transit Network


- Every transit mode serves a certain purpose and market.

Future Rail Projects





Construction Projects

- Central Mesa
 - 3.1 miles to downtown Mesa
 - In utility relocation
 - Opens late 2015
- Northwest
 - 3.2 miles to north Phoenix
 - Advanced by seven years
 - Opens late 2015/early 2016







Planning Projects

- 2.6-mile Tempe Streetcar
- 11-mile Phoenix West light rail extension
- Glendale
- Northeast Phoenix
- Gilbert Road newly funded
- South Central in AA





Arizona's Plans

- High-capacity transit between Phoenix and Tucson
 - Scoping, community input phase
 - BRT also on table
- Arizona State Rail Plan
- Commuter rail ambitions





Urban and High Speed Rail

- Connectivity is critical for passenger
- Transit needs to be at the table
- Reduce competition for same dollars
